Day of Week	Conference	Content
Monday am	Journal Club	Fellows read and discuss articles with resident and attending staff from <i>Journal of Hand Surgery</i> , <i>Journal of Shoulder and Elbow Surgery</i> and appropriate articles on the Upper Extremity from the <i>Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery</i> .
	OR Anatomy Session	OR This conference series has its own fully developed syllabus with relevant readings and also includes dissection of fresh cadavers.
Monday pm	Indications Conference (Gelberman/Yamaguchi)	Cases of the week are discussed. Readings are assigned and relevant literature is also discussed. Active participation in surgical planning is expected from the Fellows.
Tuesday am	CORE Conference	Based on CORE Curriculum designed for the Orthopaedic Residency Program. Fellows' participation in these conferences is optional, although fellows are encouraged to attend all lectures relevant to the Upper Extremity.
Tuesday pm	Indications Conference (Manske)	Cases of the week are discussed. Readings are assigned and relevant literature is also discussed. Active participation in surgical planning is expected from the Fellows.
Wednesday	Grand Rounds	Hand or Upper Extremity Presentations given once every five to six weeks by a Hand Fellow or Chief Resident on the Hand Service. Presentations are supervised by a faculty Member "sponsor". Attendance at other Grand Rounds Presentations is optional.
Thursday	Interactive Conferences	Hand/Upper Extremity Interactive Conferences are held every fourth Thursday. Fellows present a short case (usually a patient recently treated by the service) to the resident body.
Selected Fridays	Hand/Radiography Conference	Held with Dr. Louis Gilula, a noted authority on radiography of the hand and wrist
